**WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK**  
**Guthrie Baseball Association**

**When you sign this Waiver as custodial parent or legal guardian, you are certifying that you have read and understood each item and are voluntarily waiving any claim you and your Participant would have against Guthrie Baseball Association (GBA) or the City of Guthrie, in the event of any injury, damage, or loss. You are advised to consult an attorney before you sign this Waiver. You are also advised and understand that you are responsible to maintain health, life and accident insurance for your Participant, sufficient to cover any loss your Participant might incur while participating in any GBA activity. You are also authorizing prior approval for medical treatment on behalf of your Participant.**

1. I am at least eighteen (18) years of age. I understand that my Participant may be injured, fatally or otherwise, while participating in GBA activities.
2. I understand that, even if all safety rules are followed, GBA activities are potentially dangerous. I freely and voluntarily, on behalf of my Participant, accept all risks from my participant's involvement in GBA activities as a player, spectator, or otherwise.
3. I understand that, although GBA will attempt to enforce safety and playing rules, my Participant may be injured because of other persons failing to follow safety and playing rules.
4. I am completely aware of the risks for my Participant in taking part in GBA activities. I understand these risks include, but are not limited to, equipment malfunctions, violations of activity and safety rules, inclement weather conditions, and acts and omissions of other people.
5. I certify that my Participant is in good health and does not have any prohibitive condition, ailment, or other physical, mental or emotional condition which could be worsened or cause injury, illness or death as a result of my participation in any GBA activity. I understand that I am responsible for consulting with a physician regarding my Participant's medical condition before allowing my Participant to engage in any GBA activity.
6. As a condition of entering any GBA owned, managed, or leased premises, or participating in any GBA activity, I knowingly and voluntarily waive any legal rights, to the extent they may be waived pursuant to Oklahoma Law, that I, or my Participant, may have against GBA or the City of Guthrie, including their directors, officers, employees, representatives, agents, successors, and/or assigns.
7. I agree to hold harmless any and all of the above named entities, and to indemnify each and all of them against any and all claims, actions, suits, costs, expenses, damages, legal fees, and costs and liabilities arising out of, connected with, or resulting from my Participant's involvement in GBA activities, excluding indemnification of GBA for actionable occurrences not arising from my Participant's negligence or wrong doing.
8. I understand that by signing this Waiver, I freely give up certain legal rights. I understand that I must sign this Waiver as a condition of my Participant being allowed to participate in any GBA activity. I am signing this waiver voluntarily of my own free will, absent coercion, duress, undue influence or promise of benefit.
9. I agree to be bound by, and may not change, the terms of this Waiver and understand that my Participant may not take part in any GBA activity before I sign this Waiver. I understand, agree, and intend that this Waiver be binding on me and my children or wards, as well as my estate, heirs, representatives and assigns. This waiver shall remain in effect until revoked by me in writing and delivered to GBA.
10. Where deemed acceptable by any hospital, MET, or other health care professional, I hereby allow any GBA representative, Coach, Coaching Assistant, Sponsor or other person in possession of, or access to, a copy of this Waiver, to authorize any and all medical assistance and/or treatment for my Participant.
11. When you sign this agreement, you are certifying that you have read and understood each item in the Parent's Code of Ethics and the League Conduct Rules and you are voluntarily waiving any claim you may have against GBA or the City of Guthrie in the event you are sanctioned as a result of any violation of the terms of this agreement. You also agree that the ruling of the Board, following appeal from any sanction recommended or instituted by any sport committee, or any ruling by the City of Guthrie Park and Recreation Board, or any other board operation under the auspices of the City of Guthrie shall be final.

## PARENT'S CODE OF ETHICS AGREEMENT

### Guthrie Baseball Association

(Please sign separate form for each player / sibling.)

Prior to participation as a "Spectator" in any Guthrie Baseball Association (GBA) related activity or event, I agree to encourage, demand, exemplify and abide by the following:

- 1. I will comply with all GBA rules, bylaws, certifications, regulations, and decisions as well as all applicable government rules, regulations and laws.*
- 2. I will encourage and maintain an optimum sports environment for my participant, and agree to: (A) provide a drug, alcohol and carcinogenic-free environment; (B) provide proper supervision, training, equipment and first aid, while endeavoring to watch the game in tandem with good sportsmanship and citizenship; (C) provide conditioning and training instruction which seeks to optimize safety and health while minimizing injury; (D) provide assurances that my participant shall not be required, encouraged or influenced, indirectly or otherwise, to engage in any GBA activity while injured, if substantially affected, or if further degeneration is reasonably probable; (E) fairly and equally provide positive encouragement to each and every participant regardless of race, color, creed, gender, religious orientation, disability, inability, parental influence or economic status, regardless of my personal beliefs, orientations or biases; (F) provide regular verbal affirmations of the importance of education over sporting activities, while also giving educational conflicts a higher priority over those activities.*
- 3. Regardless of my personal orientation and attitudes toward winning, I will strive to exemplify and instill in my participant, that while winning may be an immediate objective, it is secondary to fairness, honesty, integrity, sportsmanship, strength of character and participation. Therefore, I will place the well being of all participants above any aspiration to win.*
- 4. I will conduct myself in a manner consistent with the purpose and aims of GBA, leading by example.*
- 5. I accept the duty and obligation to report any known illegal or unethical conduct by any Coach, Assistant Coach, Officer, Official, Spectator, Board Member or Director. I also agree to report any other misconduct reasonably calculated to negatively effect any Participant or other person or entity associated with GBA;*
- 6. I will insist and encourage my participant to play fairly, while demonstrating good sportsmanship among players, officials, fans, parents and spectators; to win or lose with dignity; to congratulate any opponent. I agree to treat officials and GBA representatives with respect, and agree to refrain from harassing any coach, player, official or spectator regardless of the situation.*
- 7. I agree to comply with any GBA sanction, ruling or decision and agree to comply with the appeal process set forth in the GBA articles and bylaws. I understand that I may request a copy of the GBA articles and bylaws, or review them during regular business hours at the GBA offices, and agree to be bound thereby. I agree to insure that my participant has completely complied with the registration process including completing all of registration forms, waivers and payment of fees.*
- 8. Baseball Parents: I agree to learn the pitching rules for my child's respective age division. I agree to follow them and help our coaches abide by the limitations imposed upon my participants; maximum number of innings pitched.*

## **LEAGUE CONDUCT RULES**

### **Guthrie Baseball Association**

**(Please complete separate form for each player / sibling.)**

- I. A coach, manager, supervisor, sponsor, spectator, participant, umpire, player or official shall not:
- a. Curse (malicious or otherwise) another manager, coach, player, umpire, or official associated with the Guthrie Baseball Association.
  - b. Push, hit, strike, or threaten an umpire, coach, player, or official of the Guthrie Baseball Association.
  - c. Be drinking or under the influence of alcohol or controlled substance while on facilities used by the Guthrie Baseball Association before, during, or after a Guthrie Baseball Association scheduled event.
  - d. Act in an irrational manner, make a public spectacle or nuisance of oneself before, during, or after a Guthrie Baseball Association scheduled event.
  - e. Violate the rules and regulations of the activity or program they are involved in.
  - f. Condone any act that undermines league policy or procedures.
  - g. Instigate with proof of two (2) witnesses any infraction listed in Rules A, B, C, D, E, or F.

II. Penalties – Violations of Rule A, E, F, or G

- a. First Offense:
  - i. Players, coaches, managers, and umpires – Dismissal for one (1) week
  - ii. Spectators – Dismissal from all Guthrie Baseball Association events for three (3) weeks
- b. Second Offense:
  - i. Dismissal from all Guthrie Baseball Association events for one (1) year.
- c. Third Offense:
  - i. Permanent dismissal from all Guthrie Baseball Association events.

III. Penalties – Violations of Rule B, C, or D

- a. First Offense:
  - i. Dismissal from all Guthrie Baseball Association events for one (1) year.
- b. Second Offense:
  - i. Permanent dismissal from all Guthrie Baseball Association events.

\*\*\* If deemed necessary by the Guthrie Baseball Association and/or the Association Board of Directors, LEGAL ACTION may be taken against the individual violating the League Conduct Rules. \*\*\*
